- The agency home of the ECAC is First Steps

**South Carolina Child Early Reading Development and Education Program**

- Established by SC Law §59-156-110
- Currently in 64 school districts serving at-risk 4 year olds
- 2019-2020: pilot year of providers' ability to serve multi-county, multi-district

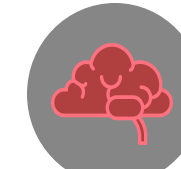
